These accompaniments are for churches or prayer groups where the singing is normally accompanied by the piano.

The songs of Taizé can be sung *a cappella*, but often an accompaniment is helpful. Here for the first time is a collection of accompaniments specifically composed for the piano.

This book contains the voices for assembly for each song, followed by a simple accompaniment, and then one or several slightly more demanding variations.

The composer of the accompaniments, **Peter Bannister**, has been close to the Taizé Community for many years. Among other prizes as composer, pianist, and organist, he received the André Caplet prize for musical composition at the French Académie des Beaux-Arts in 1999.


